Note :- Exemptions can be made by the OC on case to case basis in direct consultation with them.

Date of Camp Closing 23 December 2024

There will be veterinary arrangements at the camp sites.



Stabling arrangements:

- Open space for self creation of stables @Rs.5000/- per horse.
- Prefabricated stables @7500 will be provided on advance payment for booking before 05th Dec,2024
- Payment to be made to EXPO Management committee before the 05th Dec 2024.

Accommodation: Participants will have to arrange their own accommodation or can lease out the prefabricated tents along with their horses.

Closing date for entries is 5th December 2024 and to be made to Horse Show Management Committee along with full payments.

Weather: It is moderately cold during the month of December Participants are advised to carry woollen clothes and rugs for their horses

GENERAL INSTRUCTION

- **2nd C-PEX CHANDIGARH PET EXPO & HORSE SHOW** will be organised by CAT-Consult and managed by The Ranch Chandigarh at **Chandigarh from 21 Dec to 22 Dec 2024 under the aegis of the GADVASU.**
- **Eligibility for Participation in Events**—All participants are advised to go through the Guidelines, rules, regulations and specifications, before the event, irrespective of the extract reproduced in this prospectus.
- **Entry(s).**
 - (a) Entry(s) must be sent to the Horse Show Management Committee on prescribed entry form attachment as Appx D , along with fee deposition slip.
 - (b) No Entry will be accepted without the prescribed fee.
- **Entry Fee.**
 - (a) Normal entry fee will be as under:-
 - (i) Show Stable (15x15 ft) : Rs 35000/-per Horse.
 - (ii) Sitting Lounge with Stable : Rs 30000/- (Optional)
 - (iii) Prefabricated Resting Stables: Rs. 7500/- Horse (Optional)
 - (b) Late entry fee will be double (X2) of the normal entry fee.
 - (c) All the above fee are excluding GST.
- **Submission of Entry.** Last date for submission of entry registration is 05th December,2024.
- **Payment.** Entries must be paid through Bank transfer. Bank details for electronic payment are as under :

- **Show Number.** All horses will display the show Number on the bridle/halter
- **Abuse/ Cruelty to horses.** As per relevant rules of Animal Husbandry Department.
- **Dress Code.** When presenting a horse for the show, rider/handler should be attired in proper dress.
- **Camping & Accommodation**
 - (a) Venue & stabling will be open on 20 December 2024 and close on 23 December 2024.
 - (b) All participants should come fully equipped with their own tent age for stabling other than those who are booking prefabricated stables and enough grain and fodder for the duration of the show.
 - (c) The Organisers will try to arrange for bedding straw and fodder to be made available for sale at retail prices.
 - (d) All participants that require stables must send their requirements on or before 05 December 2024 after which late fees will be applicable.

(e) Camp fee will be charged by the Organisers as per following: -

(I) If the OC provides an area wherein the participants will build their own temporary shed, charges levied will be Rs 5000/- per horse to take care of electricity, water and cleaning charges thereof.

(II) The Organisers will ensure at all times the safety and security of the camp to avoid any mishap.

(III) All participants must inform the organisers of their total strength (personnel and animals) by the 05 December 2024, so that camp site of appropriate size can be allocated.

(IV) All teams must inform the organisers of the estimated time of arrival well in advance.

(V) The organisers will provide one bulb and electrical connection for a fan. Fans to be brought by participants.

(VI) All bio-degradable waste including horse dung is to be put in to the pits provided.

(VII) No open fires are permitted at the premises.

- **Accommodation.** All Participants are required to make arrangement for their accommodation. In Case any assistance is required you may contact Organisers/Management team.
- **Coggin's Test for Equine Infectious Anaemia & CFT for Glanders.** All rules and instructions issued by the Animal Husbandry Dept. Chandigarh and Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All animals are required to be Coggin's tested before their arrival as per policy invogue and carry a certificate to that effect in original. In addition, the animals should have CFT negative cert and certificate stating the horse is free from any infectious or contagious disease, duly signed by the Veterinary Doctor from the station the horses are coming from, which will be produced before entering the camp. Both Coggin's and CFT negative certificate, with minimum validity of 30 days on the day of arrival and exit and the Vet Certificate will be produced to the Camp OIC, failing which the horse will not be allowed inside the camp.
- **Medical cover.** The organising committee & Management committee shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to horses on the venue or the consequences there of. Each participant in the event will fill the Indemnity Bond attached and submit the same along with entry form.
- **Insurance.** The organising committee & Management committee recommends riders/club/ associations/participants to take insurance policies for competitors, personnel, grooms and horses for their transportation to venue and during the conduct of the events. The organising committee will assume no responsibility for any accident or illness due to fall of any horse, participant, groom/ any other member of the team.
- **Responsibility.** The organising committee & Management committee accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any animal or any other property or the exhibitors themselves.
- **Clearance Certificate.** Horse owners are required to obtain clearance certificate from the OC during working hours. All concerned accounts need to be cleared before they can obtain the same. No horses/ Person will be allowed to leave by the Camp in-charge without the clearance certificate.
- **Medals.** No Medals /positions /cash price will be given in any horse / participant in the show.

Appendix 'B'

DECLARATION (INDEMNITY BOND)

1. I, _____ resident of _____ desirous to participate in 2nd C-PEX CHANDIGARH PET EXPO & HORSE SHOW at Circus Ground, Sector 17, Chandigarh hereby undertake and agree: -

(a) That horse handling and all equestrian events are inherently unpredictable and potentially dangerous.

(b) That only some basic provisions for medical treatment are made at the event venue and I am responsible for my safety equipment and upkeep of my animal as well staff.

(c) That the venue of the show has various unsupervised areas that may be generally risky.

(d) That in the event of any loss or injury to property or person including injury resulting in death I or my staff may suffer while participating, I or any other legal representatives shall not hold Organising, Management and Horse Show Management Committee responsible for the same or for any consequence thereof .
